Annotations and their locations:

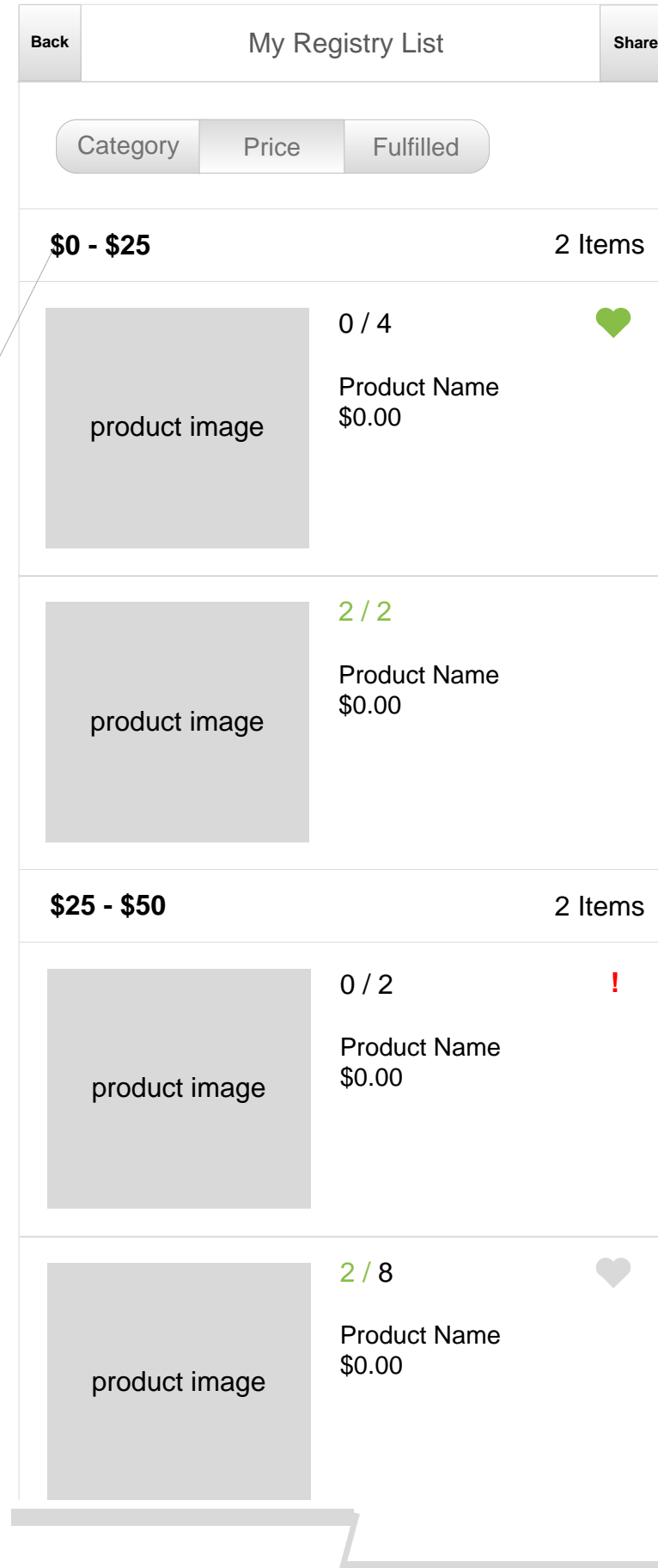
- Sorts list – category is default but selection should be sticky:** Points to the "Category" tab in the sticky header.

- Takes user to corresponding product screen (View 90.00):** Points to a "product image" placeholder in the "Dinnerware" section.
- Dynamic text displaying Has / Wants:** Points to the "0 / 4" text next to a "product image" placeholder in the "Dinnerware" section.
- IF Has != 0, Indicate with different visual treatment (see design mocks):** Points to the "2 / 2" text next to a "product image" placeholder in the "Dinnerware" section.
- Tapping icon fires layer (see view 100.40):** Points to a red exclamation mark icon next to a "product image" placeholder in the "Flatware" section.
- This text appears for 1.5 seconds immediately after user changes a grey heart to a green heart:** Points to the "Most Loved" text next to a green heart icon in the "Flatware" section.
- Users can make a broad swipe left to delete any item where HAS=0 (will bring up delete confirmation layer first - see View 180.20). Tapping anywhere within row (except on heart or NLA icon) will slide in edit layer (View 100.30):** Points to a "product image" placeholder in the "Flatware" section.
